Hello and thank you for considering a visit to Attimo Winery to support your class assignments at Virginia Tech. The information below should serve as a guide to the winery to help make your visit pleasant and fun.

Since opening to the public in the spring of 2011, Attimo has become a place to relax and enjoy our distinctive wines. Attimo Winery is dedicated to celebrating the everyday moments in life. "Attimo" means "In the Moment" in Italian. We offer special seated tastings in a relaxed atmosphere. Since 2006, Attimo has grown from a small patch of "test vines" to a large vineyard and tasting room. We are now the 2nd largest winery in the entire SW Virginia area.

Before you arrive / when you are here: Please bring a valid state-issued photo ID. A wine tasting may take between 30 min to an hour depending on how busy the Tasting room is. Wine tastings are \$5.00 for our standard menu, and, \$1.00 for each additional reserve wine. Wine tastings are usually seated, but, you may also taste at the bar. Our busiest times are Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday after 4pm, and pretty much all day on Saturdays and Sundays.

Reservations: you do not need to make reservations to come to the winery. We do wine tastings whenever we are open and continuously, however, if you are planning to come during the busy times, and, you have a party greater than 6 people, you should call ahead to make sure there is no wait.

Do we do Tours? We rarely do tours. Tours are only possible on selected Saturdays and Sundays when there are staff to do tours. We do charge \$5.00 per tour. We have arranged tours specifically for your class on the following days and encourage you to come at these times if you are required to have a tour for your class:
